

EXPERIENCED CHILD CARE PROVIDER LICENSE CAPACITIES

An Experienced Child Care Provider (ECCP) home is a licensed child care home where care is approved for nine (9) or fewer children of different age combinations as stated on the ECCP options chart below.

This chart (found at 2.310.A of the Rules Regulating Family Child Care Homes) describes the various capacity options available to the Experienced Child Care Provider. Providers may change option capacities without notifying the Department as long as the home complies with one capacity option at any one time and all other Licensing rules.
